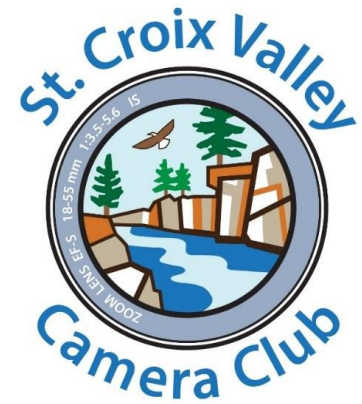

WISCONSIN INTERSTATE PARK

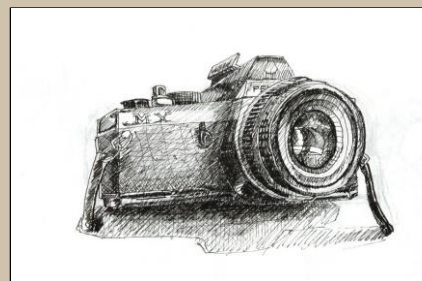
Opportunity for the Club and Individuals
